

Rabbits and shipping containers

HOW TO STOP THEM MOVING IN

Shipping containers make great storage and accommodation solutions but it's important to set them up properly.



What you can do

1. Check with your local Council to see what planning and/or building codes need to be met.
2. Site your shipping container on a concrete slab or a suitable set of piers. The piers should lift the bottom of the container to a minimum height of 40cm from the ground on all sides.
3. Where the container is on piers, avoid storing materials on the ground under the container and inspect regularly for signs of rabbits.
4. Where a concrete slab or piers cannot be used, foot netting with openings no larger than 3cm can be installed around the container to a depth of at least 40cm and must be carefully secured to the containers base.
