Rabbits and shipping containers

HOW TO STOP THEM MOVING IN

Shipping containers make great storage and accommodation solutions but it's important to set them up properly.







What you can do

- Check with your local Council to see what planning and/or building codes need to be met.
- Site your shipping container on a concrete slab or a suitable set of piers. The piers should lift the bottom of the container to a minimum height of 40cm from the ground on all sides.
- Where the container is on piers, avoid storing materials on the ground under the container and inspect regularly for signs of rabbits.
- 4. Where a concrete slab or piers cannot be used, foot netting with openings no larger than 3cm can be installed around the container to a depth of at least 40cm and must be carefully secured to the containers base.
